Dear WNAX/Tri-State Old Iron Antique Tractor Riders,

The time has come to register for the 2010 WNAX/Tri-State Old Iron 2 day tractor ride. The ride will be July 8th through July 10th. Check-In will be held on Thursday, July 8th, with the actual ride on Friday and Saturday, July 9th and 10th. This year's ride will be similar to last years, as the entire ride will originate from one location—right here in Yankton, South Dakota. We will make Paddle Wheel Point which is located next to the Chamber of Commerce as our headquarters all three days.

Registration forms are being sent out to those of you who joined us in the 2009 and the 2008 ride. This year the ride will be on a **first come basis as it is also open to the public at this time**, so get your registrations in early before the slots fill up. You need to have your registration forms postmarked by June 1, 2010 as that is the closing date for registrations or whenever 225 registrations have been received. No refunds will be made after business hours of June 1, 2010.

To help you make your overnight accommodations, we have blocked off the entire Best Western Kelly Inn at 1607 E Highway 50 in Yankton. Their telephone number is 605-665-2906. Be sure to indicate that you are a participant with the tractor ride.

Camping is available at Lewis and Clark Recreation Center (1-800-710-CAMP). There is a 90 day window for reservations at the State Camp Ground. A Federal Campground called Cottonwood Campground is also available. Reservations can be made through ReserveUSA.
